Additional Information

Blood samples must be collected using a vacutainer system in hirudin-containing tubes and must reach the laboratory within three hours. It is recommended that samples be collected as close to the courier time as possible. Patient forms for antiplatelet medications must be completed. Hemolyzed, clotted, or lipemic samples are unacceptable.

Clinical Information

Prasugrel is an antiplatelet drug that inhibits ADP-mediated platelet stimulation. The test is used to evaluate the antiplatelet activity of the drug and to identify resistance to prasugrel.
